Mr. Matthew Lasley, of Raymore, Cass county, Missouri, was kicked below the pit of the stomach on Sunday, July 23d, by a yearling colt. He suffered intensely until Wednesday, 2 p. m., when his pains ceased, and having become entirely resigned to his fate, he sank into a sleep and, at 11 o'clock p. m., he passed easily away.

Mr. Lasley was born in Addison, Gallia Co., October 6th, 1815, and was nearly 61 years old at the time of his death. In 1824, his father, Jonathan Lasley, moved to Rutland township, Meigs county. After marrying, Mr. M. Lasley removed near Kyger, Gallia county, where he was a most useful and highly respected citizen for some 31 years. About 6 years ago he moved to Cass county, Mo., where he met death in this unlooked for way.

He leaves a wife (sister of Mr. John A. Eakin of our town) and eight sons, two of whom live here: J. L. Lasley and D. H. Lasley, Jr. He was a brother of Judge W. H. Lasley, Capt. D. H. Lasley, A. J. Lasley, Mrs. W. V. Lasher, and Mrs. J. S. Eakin.

DIED.—MATTHEW LASLEY, Esq., of Big Creek Township, Cass Co., July 26, in the 61st year of his age.

A good man and worthy citizen has been called away. On Sabbath morning he was attending to his horses in the barn when he received a kick from a horse from which he died on Wednesday evening.

He was born in Gallia county, Ohio, and moyed to Missouri in 1870, and improved the farm upon which he has since lived. He never professed religion, but always attended church and took a far deeper interest in religion than a casual observer would have supposed. But in his last illness, he left no doubt as to his hope of a better life. Talked freely and calmly, said, "I know that I have not lived the christian life that I should; I might have done better; but I have tried to deal honestly with all men. I think my greatest sin was profanity, and will say to my boys, live closer to the cross of Jesus Christ than I have done. If I have any enemies, I forgive them as I hope to be forgiven. All I can do, is to place my trust in a merciful God." His excellent family added much to the improvement and character of the most worthy neighborhood of which he formed so important a part. He was a worthy citizen, and the large attendance at his funeral, and the many tears shed over his remains, show clearly the high esteem in which he was held by all who knew him. He leaves a wife and eight sons to sorely feel the loss of such a husband and father. May God's love and love sustain them, and a father's now them.
