Tennessee Library Technology Training Grant

The Tennessee State Library and Archives is pleased to provide a grant opportunity to public libraries within the regions in Tennessee for public computer training labs and classes. The Library Technology Training Grant is available for public libraries to create or update training labs for the express purpose of providing free public training on computer skills. Grant funds are available for the following:

- The purchase of laptops or mobile devices for public training use (either as a new purchase or replacement of existing hardware);
- To purchase the services of trainers for computer classes; or
- To purchase laptops or mobile devices and paid trainers.

Please be aware that this is a competitive grant, which means that each application will be scored and grant awards will be based on the scores received. The project budget is \$400,000.00 Grant awards are in the amount of up to \$10,000.00, and each grant will require a 10% local match.

The Grant will run from May 1, 2017 – April 30, 2019.
