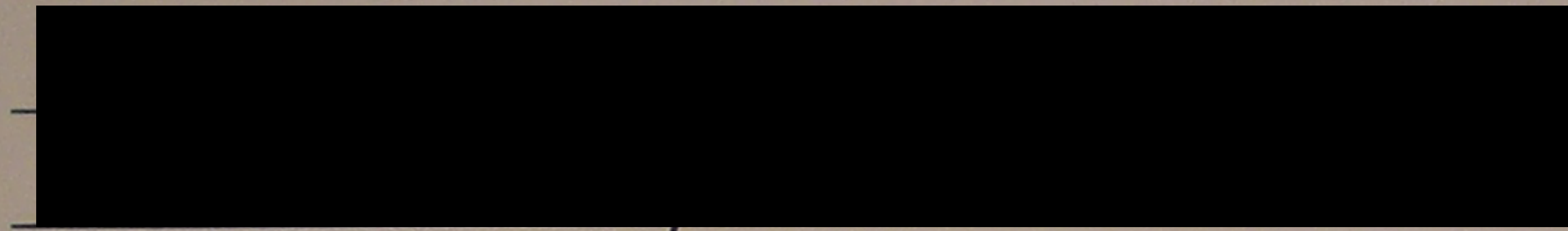

Family Bible of Griffin T. Skinner

This bible is a 4 X 7 inch size, and was published in 1850 by The American Bible Society of New York. Pages 383 through 463 are missing. By the time it came to me in September of 1980, it was in pieces. The binding was disintegrated, and both back and front covers were disjoined. In January of 1981 I had it rebound and covered in black Morocco leather, as faithful to the original as possible. The loose pages were restitched. The work was done by Custom Bindery and Specialties on South Tryon St. in Charlotte, Barbara Daniels a native of Statesville, NC, owner. She assigned the job to Bobby Moore, a 39 year veteran in the bindery trade. The old covers were sealed in archival pouches, and placed in the file of Griffin T. Skinner. While the cover is new, the pages remain brittle and moderately foxed, therefore caution must be observed. To prevent unnecessary handling I have extracted all the legible writing.
